What is a Privacy Notice

A privacy notice helps your Doctors surgery tell you how it uses information it has about you, like your name, date of birth and all of the notes the Doctor or nurse makes about you in your medical health record

Why do we need one?

Your Doctors surgery needs a privacy notice to make sure it meets the legal requirements which are written in a new document called the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR for short)

What is GDPR?

What a great question! The GDPR is a new document that helps your Doctors surgery keep the information we hold about you securely. It is new and will be introduced on the 25th May 2018. We want to ensure you that we know about it and will do everything we can to keep your information safe and secure.

In the Surgery we will have posters and leaflets to give to children and adults and we also have lots of information about privacy on our website, telling you how we use the information we hold about you.

What information do we collect about you?

Don't worry we will only collect information that we need to keep you healthy such as your name, address, details of who your mum and dad are or guardians, records of appointments, visits and telephone calls.

If you have any worries about the information we do hold or anything that might be wrong with your record you just have to ask to speak to the Practice Manager. If you do not want to share your information this is also important to let us know.
